DYU-COM provides diverse clinical education which includes many rotations in different hospitals and office settings. For select core rotations; Internal Medicine, Surgery, Pediatrics, Psychiatry, Obstetrics and Gynecology, Family Medicine the supervising physician faculty member must and will be board certified or eligible for their specific practice in medicine. For other rotations, Community Medicine, Ambulatory Medicine, Neuromuscular Medicine, Emergency Medicine, and electives the supervising physician faculty member should ideally be board certified but is not mandatory. To ensure our students receive the highest quality training the Dean, the Associate Dean for Clinical Medical Education and the Curriculum Committee will assess the credentials of a non-board certified or eligible physician and will decide if the physician is an adequate clinical educator and physician faculty member.
